**RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**  
**Agreement for College Housing**

The Housing Department of the Miami Tribe (MTHD), under the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996, has rental assistance funding available (\$50/month) for eligible students that are enrolled at Miami University. To be and remain eligible, a Miami Tribe member must be enrolled as a full time student at Miami University, be compliant with the Miami University Student Code of Conduct, and be in good academic standing (2.0 GPA minimum) with the University.

The following provisions are incorporated as the agreement between the Housing Authority of the Miami Tribe (MTHA) and **tenant/student** listed below.

1. **Name of Student and Mailing Address in Ohio**

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2. **Term of the Agreement.** The term of the RAP Agreement begins on the same month as the first day of the school term and terminates on the last day of the same month of the school term during which the tenant/student is enrolled full time in Miami University classes.

3. **Rental Assistance Payment.** The payment in the amount of \$50.00 will be sent to the student at the address provided above at the beginning of each month. The student must renew the agreement **each semester** by contacting the Heritage Coordinator at Miami University (Bobbe Burke) who will notify the Miami Tribe Housing Authority of eligible students. It is the responsibility of each student to notify the Heritage Coordinator of any change of student status.
4. **A copy of tribal member's enrollment card must accompany this application.**
5. **Income Verification of Family. (Definition of Family includes a family with or without children, an elderly family, a near-elderly family, a disabled person and/or a single person.)**

**If your parent(s) claim you on their taxes them we have to take their income. If not then we only need your income.**

Copy of **Family's** last year's IRS 1040 or 1048 income tax form or copy of your last three (3) employment check stubs.

By signing below you are Self Certifying that all reportable income is being disclosed to the Miami Tribe Housing Authority. This program is funded through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Under Sec. 4. 25.U.S.C. 4102, the Miami Tribe Housing Department is required to have income verification for each eligible client.

Example of current 2007 income guide lines. A family of 1 person can make up to \$ 33,400; a family of 2 - \$38,150; a family of 3-\$42,500; a family of 4- \$47,700; a family of 5-\$51,500; a family of 6-\$55,300.
