As an EMT-B employed by Ohio Ambulance Service, LLC, you will be required to meet such qualifications as professional communication with medical staffs, departments, facilities, co-workers, patients and family members. You must also maintain a professional and mature attitude and appearance, and you must apply knowledgeable and correct judgment to recognize and define problems while under stress.

BASIC RESPONSIBILITIES

Under the direction of the General Manager and EMS Manager, the EMT-B assumes responsibility for providing emergency and non-emergency ambulance service whenever and wherever needed. The EMT-B provides care and assistance to victims of serious illness or injury. The EMT-B will participate in all mandatory Run Reviews, staff meetings, and in-service programs. The EMT-B provides medical transportation for the critically ill or injured patient and maintains in proper working order all vehicles and equipment.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES:

- Provide staffing for the ambulance.
- Complete checking of squad equipment at the start of each shift.
- Develop and maintain skills and knowledge of all equipment on board.
- Respond to all emergency/non-emergency requests within a reasonable time period.
- Display increasing proficiency in skills and procedures.
- Must complete the EMT-B refresher course. (Must be completed within the three (3) year period prior to expiration date).
- Assist Paramedics in invasive procedures when necessary.
- Must have the ability to attach electrodes and monitor leads to patient.
- Must have the ability to spike an IV bag.
- Ability to show proficiency in all Basic EMT skills.
- Complete and obtain necessary paperwork on all transports as instructed by the Billing Department.
- Communicate staffing and equipment requirements to the EMS Manager or EMS Asst. Manager.
- Maintain vehicles in good working order by keeping vehicle clean and checking fluids on every shift.
- Assist in the orientation of new employees.



- Assist our Ambulette Division with transports as deemed necessary by the Communication Center Staff.
- Responsible for complete communication with your Dispatcher while on shift. This includes, but is not limited to: calling in and out of all origins and destinations, calling out when clear, and verifying traffic every 15 minutes while sitting idle.
- Must clean vehicle inside and out and fuel up after every shift.
- Must decontaminate squad after every shift and record it on Decon Record Sheet.
- Must have the ability to transport patients onto and off of cots, into and out of squad, and into and out of origins and destinations.
- Must have the ability to operate the following types of patient transport equipment;
 - Ferno Model 30 and 35A
 - All Stryker Models
 - Stairchairs
 - Wheelchairs

EDUCATION AND WORK EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:

- High School Graduate or GED equivalent
- Certified by the State of Ohio as an EMT-B
- Must maintain a current State of Ohio driver's license
- Completion of CPR Course C

WORKING CONDITIONS

Working conditions are normal for the EMS environment with the majority of your shift(s) spent in an Ambulance. Work may require weekend, evening and overnight work. Work may require overnight travel.
